### 1. What is the ASIA PICKLEBALL OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP (APO)?

The ASIA PICKLEBALL OPEN Championship is the Asia tier 4 stop of the WPC Series (World Pickleball Championship Series).

Together with other stops **2024 EUROPEAN PICKLEBALL OPEN** and **2024 OCEANIA PICKLEBALL OPEN**, **2024 ASIA PICKLEBALL OPEN** leads to the **2024 WORLD PICKLEBALL CHAMPIONSHIP** with the goal to reward the best players in the world with the WORLD PICKLEBALL CHAMPION title at the end of the year.

**WPC Series use GPR** (Global Pickleball Rankings) and **APO is a tier 4 tournament** offering the players the second most ranking points.

The ASIA PICKLEBALL OPEN Championship is a **20,000 USD** Pickleball Tournament. The ASIA PICKLEBALL OPEN Championship includes 19+, 35+, 50+, 60+, OPEN, Advanced, and Intermediate divisions over the course of the 5-day Championship.

### 2. How does the GPR (Global Pickleball Rankings) work?

- it is based on the best 15 results in the prior 52 weeks
- players earn points for all games won
- the number of points is determined by the skill level and the tier of the competition
- the points are the same for all the age groups
- players can view their ranking at global level, continental level, and country-level according to their age groups
- players can play at different levels either with younger players or in higher skill levels (the higher the level the more points)
- every player has a HAR (Home Age Ranking) where all the points accumulated by the player over the last 52 weeks are being posted, regardless of the ranking points have been acquired by playing in the player's home age event or by competing with the younger players

#### 3. REGISTRATION DEADLINE

The deadline to REGISTER is January 20, 2024.

#### 4. WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE

Cancellation and refund requests must be made by 11:59 pm Thailand time on January 20, 2024

#### 5. WHO CAN PLAY AT THIS EVENT?

**ASIA PICKLEBALL OPEN Championship is open to all players from around the world.** You do not need to be a citizen or a resident in any of Asia countries.

### 6. TRAVELING TO THAILAND

There is no need to provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination to travel to and from Thailand. Mask wearing on international flights to Thailand is no longer mandatory. Travelers continue to be encouraged to consider wearing a mask to reduce their personal risk of contracting and spreading COVID-19.

### 12. Daily Schedules

There will be TWO sessions every day – Morning and Afternoon.

**Players can register ONLY to the divisions that would not conflict in the time** – one in the morning and one in the afternoon.

Usually, they will be able to register to "two skill neighboring divisions" such as "open and advanced" or "advanced and intermediate".

Similarly, if a player wants to play in two OPEN divisions, they can do it only in "two age neighboring divisions" such as "35+ and 19+" or "50+ and 35+".
